Each child participating in the quiz will receive eco-friendly gifts from the "Silesia. Blue Sky Restored" project.

Adults will have the opportunity to speak with the eco-manager, who will explain the practical implementation of the anti-smog resolution, the consequences of burning waste, and sustainable solutions to improve air quality in the region.
